To this day, the 2 churches maintain their spiritual connection through worship, fellowship, community outreach and most of all, a shared love of the gospel. From humble beginnings, much has changed in the world, in our community, and the life of the church, but the hearts and souls of those that remain are set on Jesus and to passing on our faith to future generation.

 - One (1) from a friend
 - One (1) from a layperson

*Final candidates must consent to a reference check, a full background check including criminal history, a drug test and credit check. These checks will be conducted by an outside agency for complete confidentiality.

Interview/Selection Process:

Phase 1: Each applicant's information (resume, credentials, references, etc.) will be carefully reviewed for consideration.

Phase 2: Candidates deemed a potential fit by the committee will be asked to proceed with a virtual interview. In any event, all candidates will be notified timely of the committee's intent.

Phase 3: Once the candidate has completed their initial interview the committee will prayerfully deliberate to determine next steps. In any event, all candidates will be notified timely of the committee's intent.

Phase 4: If logistically feasible, Committee members will travel to worship with the candidate and their current congregation. (OPTIONAL)

Phase 5: Qualified candidates will be invited to deliver a Sunday sermon and teach a lesson.

Phase 6: Only the most highly qualified candidate will be recommended to the church to cast their votes for the next pastor.

Clarksburg is often referred to as the "Jewel of the Hills." Located in the Mountaineer Country region, offers visitors a rich mix of retail, industrial, professional, and governmental services. Clarksburg's unique blend of history, natural beauty, and community spirit makes it a noteworthy city in the heart of West Virginia.

Local Demographics

Clarksburg is a city in and the county seat of Harrison County, West Virginia, United States, in the north-central region of the state. The population of the city was 16,039 at the 2020 census, making it the tenth-largest city in West Virginia. The racial makeup of the city was White =88%, African American =3.9%, Hispanics or Latinos =3%, Asian =0.5%, Native American =0.2%, Other =0.9%, and two or more races =6.4%. Everyone is friendly and kindness abounds particularly within the Christian community.

Local Economy & Commerce

Today, high tech, aerospace, criminal justice, and energy exploration drive the area's economy. The city has a daily newspaper, The Exponent-Telegram, three local television stations, and six radio stations. Clarksburg is home to Eastpointe and Newpointe, the largest strip mall in West Virginia, adjacent to Interstate 79. Most of Clarksburg's retail has relocated to the strip malls, and downtown is now home to many professional services. In July 1995, the Federal Bureau of Investigation completed construction on its Criminal Justice Information Services Division complex in Clarksburg. The \$200 million complex, located on 986 acres, is the national repository for the FBI's law enforcement records. Also visit Meadowbrook Mall, where you will find the area's Best Shopping, Dining and Entertainment.

Culture

Clarksburg is a cultural center of the north-central West Virginia region and hosts many events and festivals. Watch movies and live performances at the Robinson Grand Performing Arts Center. Since 1979 Clarksburg has hosted the annual West Virginia Italian Heritage Festival held during Labor Day weekend. Every September since 1991 the city has been the site of the West Virginia Black Heritage Festival. Since 2006 Clarksburg has hosted the annual Glen Elk Wine, Music, and Arts festival. Since 1997 Clarksburg has also hosted the Greater Clarksburg 10K race, the official WV 10K State Championship. In 2007 the race was renamed the Jarvis Greater Clarksburg 10K. West Virginia Heritage Crafts is the state's oldest artisan co-op offering everything from jams and jellies to quilted items.

Entertainment & Recreation

Watch movies and live performances at the Robinson Grand Performing Arts Center. Tee off at the Clarksburg Country Club, an 18-hole, par 68 course. Take the family to the Clarksburg Splash Zone to cool off from the summer heat. The 385,000-gallon water park includes a lazy river, waterslides and a 25-meter competition pool.
