ABWOTS Open Positions

Coordinator of Mission with Women and Girls promotes the vision for all women and girls to have opportunities to live in the fullness of God's purpose for their lives; studies issues related to executive committee's current emphases on women and girls and suggests materials for study and action; promotes the Women and Girls Mission Fund and special mission projects that empower women and girls; suggests ideas for education and promotion of mission related resources. (This position began at the National level in 2013).

Coordinator of Events provides leadership in planning all regional women's events sponsored by ABWOTS; oversees and delegates tasks in the implementation of regional ABWOTS meetings and conferences; assures that the conference revenues exceed expenses; and leads the budgeting process for upcoming conferences working with the Treasurer.

Coordinator of AB Girls is responsible for the regional Gathering of Girls and promotes AB GIRLS.

Coordinator of Love Gift is responsible for the education and promotion of the Love Gift offering.

Area President positions for Area I, II, III, IV, V and VI are also open.

Highlights from ABWOTS Annual Leadership Seminar and Business Meeting

On Tuesday, April 30, in Richmond, Virginia, we held our ABWOTS Annual Leadership Seminar and Business Meeting as a part of the ABCOTS 54th Annual Session. Our theme for the program was "Be Strong, Be Courageous: Building Your Body, Mind and Spirit". We proudly hosted sixty women from the seven areas of ABCOTS. The meeting room was filled with positive energy and excitement, this being our first fully in-person meeting since COVID-19.

We were blessed to have two very dynamic speakers during the Leadership Seminar covering topics from women's health and wellness to physical fitness and exercise. Dr. Deborah Parham-Hopson covered some of the top health issues facing black women today such as heart disease, breast health, black maternal health, mental health, and spiritual health. She also spoke about health disparities between black women and those of other races and some of the causes. Her presentation was very engaging, leading to numerous questions from the participants which she welcomed and responded to thoughtfully. Dr. Kristin Kelley, our wellness facilitator for the morning, stressed the importance of physical fitness. She gave us pointers about proper posture, safe lifting, and even guided us through some simple exercises that we can do almost anywhere.

We also heard from Ms. Jasmine Snead, Communications Manager with Housing Families First, our mission outreach partner for this year. She told us about some the work being done at the Hilliard House to assist homeless families in the Richmond area. On behalf of Housing Families First, she expressed heartfelt gratitude for ABWOTS donating to the Hilliard House. The ABWOTS Executive Committee also wants to thank all of you and your churches for the generous donations to the Hillard House, making this year's outreach project a great success.

During our Business Meeting we elected Sister Angelia Mumford to fill the new position of Vice-President. Sister Mumford is no stranger to us, having served on the ABWOTS Executive Committee for many years. Her biography is included on page 2 of this issue. We made a plea for volunteers to fill the vacant positions on the Executive Committee that now include Coordinator of Missions with Women and Girls, AB Girls Coordinator, Love Gift Coordinator and Area President for Areas I through VI. In addition, we now need to fill the much-needed position of Event Coordinator.

We set aside time during our Business Meeting to recognize women who have been involved in church ministries, ABCOTS, and/or have supported ABCOTS ministry objectives for over 25 years by awarding them with the ABWOTS Silver+ Recognition. It takes women willing to give of themselves as these women have for so many years to keep our churches and ABWOTS strong as we move into the future. Congratulations again to the recipients (page 4). Remember, your pastor's approval is required for you to be considered for this award.

We sincerely appreciated your participation in the women's programs and your valuable feedback in the evaluations. We received twenty-nine responses, the majority of which indicated the event met or exceeded their expectations. The most positive feedback was on the speakers and content of the leadership seminar. Respondents thought the topics were very appropriate for our first completely in-person post-COVID program. The participants really enjoyed the wellness games including gift cards to the winners. Overall, the women were very happy to be able to meet again in person to fellowship with sisters from across the region.

Suggestions for improving the program included:

- better allocation of time for the Leadership Seminar since some respondents felt it was a bit rushed,
- respondents really appreciated the Silver+ Recognition being included, but some felt it would be better to have it during the Leadership Seminar in the morning rather than after lunch since some attendees needed to leave early.

Suggested topics for future seminars included:

- Youth and teen related discussions, including how to engage youth,
- Mental health awareness discussion,
- More discussions to strengthen women overall and
- Discussion about ancestry.

We were delighted to have American Baptist Women's Ministries (ABWM) Interim Executive Director, Rev. LaThelma Yenn Batah and some members of her staff join us for the day, as well as representatives from International Ministries.
